

WORLD OF SNOW LEOPARDS


-  Not afraid of **heights**.
-  **Extremely elusive** and therefore challenging to survey.
-  Happy in **cold climates** as they have thick fur coats.
-  Live in **high elevation alpine environments** with rugged terrain

-  Walk or run a minimum of **700 meters**, 100 meters for each of the 7 species of Big Cats.
-  To represent your knowledge of the Snow Leopard, after your initial walk or run:
  1. **Add a gradient to your walk**, as if you are climbing a mountain.
  2. **Do your walk at altitude** to reflect the mountainous habitat of the Snow Leopard.
  3. **Customize your Catwalk outfit** with patterns inspired by the Snow Leopard's distinctive coat.
  4. Make a **Snow Leopard mask** using our cut-out and wear it on your Catwalk!
-  After you have completed your Catwalk, **share your story** by adding the hashtag **#Catmosphere** to your social media posts.


